Components of well-being as identified in published reviews

Inclusion Criteria for the Review

Criteria	Description
Population	Families that include an individual with an intellectual
	disability and family members of those with an
	intellectual disability
Interventions	n/a – observational studies
Comparisons	Not required, but allowed
Outcomes	Family well-being or some component (ex. caregiver
	mental health, sibling quality-of-life)
Clinical settings	n/a – observational studies
Geographic	Research conducted in the United States or in
setting	populations similar to U.S. populations with services
	and interventions applicable to U.S. practice
Study Designs	Case-control studies or cohorts; qualitative studies;
Timing	Published in 2000 or later
Languages	Full text published in English
Publication type	Systematic reviews, scoping reviews, meta-analyses
